#### Kindergarten:

- Fifteen Elmer's glue sticks

- Four plain plastic folders with pockets and brads \*Two: blue, Two: red (1 for Inquiry Lab)
- One composition notebook wide ruled, any color
- One primary composition notebook, any color
- One pair of blunt tip scissors
- One 1" binder with pockets (forAgenda; any color)

- Four dozen SHARPENED #2 pencils
- Four Elmer's glue sticks

- Three plain plastic folders with pockets and brads \*One: blue, green, yellow (Inquiry Lab)
- One composition notebook wide ruled, any color
- One 1" binder with pockets (for Agenda; any color)
- One 3-ring pencil pouch

### Fifth Grade:

- Four dozen SHARPENED #2 pencils
- Four Elmer's glue sticks
- Eight black dry erase markers
- One box (12 count) colored pencils
- One self-contained pencil sharpener
- Five plain, plastic folders with pockets and brads \*One: red, yellow, green, blue, purple(Inquiry lab)
- Two composition notebooks wide ruled, any color
- Five 1-subject spiral notebooks \*2 green, 2 blue, 1 yellow
- One 1" binder with pockets \*(For Agenda; any color)
- One pencil pouch
- One pack of colored pens
- Two packs of loose-leaf paper wide ruled
