# **IB Instructional Elements**

<u>Theme-</u> Our IB curriculum is comprised of six transdisciplinary units that have global significance and offers students the opportunity to explore human experiences.

<u>Who We Are:</u> an inquiry into the nature of the self, beliefs and values, personal, physical, mental, social, and spiritual health; human relationships including families, friends, communities, and cultures; rights and responsibilities; what it mean to be human.

• Lincoln Curriculum Connection— Students will express themselves based on their beliefs and values and those of people around them.

#### **Learner Profile**

The Learner Profile is a set of attributes that, taken as a whole, lay the foundation upon which international-mindedness will develop and flourish

- <u>Courageous:</u> We approach uncertainty with forethought and determination; we work independently and cooperatively to explore new ideas and innovative strategies.
- **LAA Curriculum Connection:** Students spend a day at *Give Kids the World* learning how to provide help to the needs of children with terminal illnesses.
- Caring: Showing empathy, compassion and respect for others.
- LAA Curriculum Connection: Students will redesign the school and will take part in the community organization Give Kids the World.
- **Balanced:** We understand the importance of balancing di-erent aspects of our lives—intellectual, physical, and emotional—to achieve well-being for ourselves and others.
- **LAA Curriculum Connection:** Students will present their choice of media their possible solutions to help overcome challenges related to a chosen disability.

#### <u>Attitudes</u>

Attitudes are expressions of fundamental values, beliefs and feelings about learning, the environment and people.

- **Tolerance:** Being sensitive towards someone with a disability.
- LAA Connection: Students will become sensitive towards someone with a disability.
- **Empathy:** Experiencing various disabilities to be able to understand how others live.
- LAA Connection: Students will experience various disabilities to be able to understand how others live.

## **Key Concepts**

Key Concepts are powerful ideas that have relevance within the subject areas but also transcend them and that students must explore and reexplore in order to develop a coherent, in-depth understanding.

- **Function-** The understanding that everything has a purpose, a role or a way of behaving that can be investigated.
- **LAA Connection** Students will rotate rooms to experience life as if they were abled differently.
- Form- The understanding that everything has a form with recognizable features that can be observed, identified, described and categorized.
- **LAA Connection-** Students will analyze how the structures of the body systems formed and deformed.
- <u>Perspective-</u> The understanding that knowledge is moderated by perspectives; different perspectives lead to different interpretations, understandings and findings; perspectives may be individual, group, cultural or disciplinary.
- **LAA Connection** Students will learn about appreciating different perspectives of those with abled differently.

## **Transdisciplinary Skills**

These skills are capabilities that students need to demonstrate to succeed in a changing, challenging world, which may be disciplinary or transdisciplinary in nature.

- **Thinking skills** apply knowledge to create their own assistive device
- **LAA Connection-** Students will apply knowledge new knowledge of organs in the human body and it's function, laws of motion and work of machines, to create a new device using Lego Mindstorms
- Social skills- group decision making to plan and create robotic device
- <u>LAA Connection-</u> Students will create blueprint reengineering classrooms to become more accesibile to visitors
- Self-management skills: use time management and spatial awareness to explore and create an accessible blueprint of the school
- **LAA Connection—**Students will create a protocol that will assure safety and mobility of visitors by designing a school map that includes routes and protocols for evacuation in case of emergency.
